UNPACKING INSTRUCTIONS

- Carefully unpack your fan, taking care not to damage or deform any fan parts. Retain fan box temporarily in case a return is necessary. Should any parts be missing, contact Patterson customer service immediately at (800) 768-3985.
- Inspect the fan for damage of any kind (dents, paint scrapes, motor damage, etc.).
- If possible, test the operation of the fan prior to installation using the appropriate power source for the motor.

GENERAL SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING: To reduce the risk of fire or electrical shock, do not use this product with any solid-state speed control device. To reduce the risk of fire or electric shock and injury to persons, do not use in a window.

- **DO** unplug your circulator before cleaning.
- **DO** clean your fan regularly. Refer to the CLEANING & MAINTENANCE instructions provided. Never clean the fan in any manner other than as instructed in this manual.
- **DO NOT** use gasoline, thinners, solvents, ammonia, or other chemicals for cleaning.
- **DO NOT** immerse this product in water or allow water to drip into the motor housing.
- **DO NOT** use near furnaces, fireplaces, stoves, or other high temperature heat sources.
- **DO NOT** use this product outdoors.
- **DO NOT** use this product on wet surfaces.
- **DO NOT** operate any fan with a damaged cord or plug.
- **DO NOT** carry this product by the cord or use the cord as a handle.
- **DO NOT** allow unqualified personnel to service or maintain the equipment.
- **DO NOT** operate this product without factory provided guards.
- **DO** use common sense when using this product and/or any electrical appliance.

ELECTRICAL INSTALLATION

Your licensed electrician is responsible for providing all electrical components and making all necessary connections from the motor to the appropriate power source.

All Patterson fans come with a wiring schematic, usually printed on the nameplate of the motor. Fans must be wired exactly as shown. In the case of a dual voltage motor, take care to select the correct wiring configuration based on your voltage level. Have electrical questions? Call before you connect – improper wiring can damage motors, cause injury, and affect warranty coverage.

It is highly recommended that all fans have an independent disconnect switch located within visual sight of the fan. This switch should be used in conjunction with all “lock out, tag out” procedures during service and maintenance.

CAUTION: All wiring connections, inspection, and maintenance of any motor must be performed by a licensed electrician in accordance with the motor manufacturer’s recommendations, all electrical codes, and OSHA regulations. Failure to properly install, wire, or perform any maintenance to a motor can result in motor failure, property damage, injury, or death.

WARNING: The installation and use of a Patterson Fan must be in accordance with the requirements specified in the installation manual and with any additional requirements set forth by the national electric code (NEC) and all local codes. Failure to comply with these codes could result in personal injury or property damage.

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

All Patterson Fans are designed to be virtually maintenance free, but routine cleaning and inspection should be performed on a regular basis. Clean the fan of all dust, dirt, and grease. Any mild car wash soap will suffice. Avoid strong acid/alkaline cleaners such as Purple Power or Simple Green. Regular cleaning will keep the fan operating safely at optimal performance levels.

On an annual basis, we recommend that you inspect the following:

- Tightness and integrity of the blade
- Integrity of motor mounts and welds
- Tightness of the safety finger/hand guards
- Tightness of bolts of mounting brackets
- Security of attachment to wall or other structural member
- Security of the safety chain or cable
